



## SouthPointe Farmers' Market Vendor Licenses

Some vendors will be required to have a license depending on the products that they are selling. If you have any specific questions about licenses, please contact the Market manager at (614) 491- 4115. Contact information for the Department of Health is also listed below.

1. Vendors serving the following products **MUST** have a food license:
    - Meats
    - Eggs
    - Dairy
  2. If vendors are serving the products listed above (i.e. meats, eggs, dairy), then one of the following licenses must be obtained:
    - A temporary license from the Department of Health.
    - A mobile food license from the county the vendor resides.
  3. Vendors serving only fresh fruits, vegetables, and/or herbs are **NOT** required to have a license.
  4. Vendors do **NOT** need a license for the following products:
    - Jellies
    - Fruit Butters
    - Jams
    - Baked Goods
    - Candies
- \*All packaged products must be properly labeled with **ingredient list, weight, allergens, and contact information.**
5. Vendors are permitted to provide samples of their products at the Farmers' Market. A license is not required.
